With direction from the Special Programs Director, this position plans, organizes and conducts social, recreational and educational activities in the existing Extended Day program.

Job Responsibilities

- Supervise elementary and middle school students Monday-Friday, 10-20 hours per week
- Collaborate with the Special Programs Director to plan and implement engaging age-appropriate activities for indoor spaces and outdoor playground
- Maintain a safe and positive learning environment
- Foster positive relationships with parents, students and school faculty on a daily basis

Qualifications and Experience

- Bachelor's degree in education, recreation, child development or related field preferred, but not required.
- Experience working with children in a school setting
- Excellent reading, writing, and verbal communications in English
- Demonstrated ability to take initiative and to work passionately and joyfully with children
- Possess strong judgment, discretion, and problem solving skills
- Pass background check, fingerprint clearance and must have a current TB skin test or TB clearance
