

Register Now for Back to School Night/ All-School Meeting Childcare!

Limited childcare is available for no fee for pre-registered SFS students from 4:30-8:30 p.m. on September 7th and September 14th (Elementary/Middle School Back to School Night) and 6:15-8:30 pm on September 27 (All School Meeting & Potluck) *if you register before the deadlines (see below)*. Pizza will be served during the All School Meeting ONLY.

Registering after the deadline will be \$15 per child and showing up without any advance notice is \$30 per child, all to be billed directly to you. **Note: There will be no drop-ins on September 27 to ensure pizza amounts and teacher to student ratios.**
