There were two questions that were recurrent throughout the day:

Is it okay for students to get together outside of school during the closure?

We have been advised that in the absence of confirmed or suspected COVID-19 at the SFS, <u>small</u> group gatherings of healthy children (with distancing of 3 or more feet between children in the gathering, if possible) should be permitted to prevent the detrimental effects of social isolation during school closure on children. This also takes into account the need for parents to earn and provide essential services as workers. Adults older than 60 or with pre-existing conditions that make them more vulnerable to illness should be cautious and minimize exposure to the child groups.

Will the school closure extend beyond one week?

We are aware that SFUSD & many of the other local independent schools have announced longer
closures. We will continue to assess the situation, and as soon as we know more, we will update
