Math:

Aim for at <u>least</u> 2 math sessions/week of 20-30 minutes.

- How Much is Your Name Worth Video (How Much is Your Name Worth?)
- Math Mystery Video (Math Mystery Packet)

Writing and Handwriting:

Aim for at least 2 writing sessions/week of 20-30 minutes.

Summer Writing Video (My Summer Writing Journal Packet)

Reading:

Aim for at least 3 reading sessions/week of 20-30 minutes.
