In addition to reading and annotating *The Outsiders*, write an alternate ending to the novel in the same style of Hinton, which means first-person, detailed characterization, and a strong voice/style. You may pick up from any point of the story to write your alternate ending. The ending should be typed, 12 point font, double spaced, and 1-2 pages in length. This will be printed in class and turned in the first week of school.
